## **Review day**



We held an Experts by Experience Review Day on 14th November at Llanthony Secunda Priory in Gloucester.

11 Barnwood Staff were joined by 10 Experts by Experience, who are also Barnwood Circle members, to review all of the projects that have taken place this year.

It was great to hear about the positive impact for everyone of being involved in these projects. We also heard about the overall project outcomes. It was a very moving and productive day as we reflected on the Trust's co-production journey.

Participants mentioned that their involvement in Experts by Experience projects was purposeful, worthwhile and that they had felt valued. Many people also found it rewarding to be able to contribute to projects where there were tangible outcomes.

# Meetup 'round up'

As we reach the end of the year of Barnwood Circle meetups we ended with ones this week in the Forest of Dean and Stroud.



We have held almost 30 meetups, online and across the county in 2022. We have discussed **Transport**, **Access to Green Spaces and Employment** and heard the views, ideas, and experiences of over 100 people.



To date, our members number 75. That's 75 people from around the county who are passionate about making a difference to the lives of disabled people, neurodivergent people and people with mental health challenges.

# **Empowered Employers campaign**

Disabled people, neurodivergent people and people with mental health challenges face a complex range of barriers to accessing meaningful employment. These barriers show up in attitudes, financial barriers, spaces, policies, and practices.

Empowered Employers has been designed by a team at Barnwood, with a group of organisations and businesses in Gloucestershire including Creed Catering Services, Clean Slate CIC, Hooray Recruitment, Hydro Aluminium and Renishaw. ...employing disabled people will give me even more problemsources!

Alongside the partners, a group of Experts by Experience are also working with us; people with a lived experience of disability and mental health challenges to help us shape the campaign. These Experts by Experience are Barnwood Circle members and are vital in the development of this campaign. We would like to personally thank those 6 original Circle members and our 2 newcomers to the group, without whom we would not have been able to launch a clear and impactful campaign to be proud of.



# Digital Inclusion Fund announcements

As we reported in the last Round Up, over the summer, Barnwood has taken applications for a new Digital Inclusion Fund. We've worked with a 'Lived and Learned Experience Funding Panel' which included 5 Barnwood Circle members.

This funding was for projects that help to remove barriers for people who want to be a part of the digital world. After receiving 14 applications, the panel made recommendations for 6 projects to be funded and the Barnwood Trust Board of Trustrees agreed with the recommendations.
