Empowered Employers

We will be working with Barnwood's Insights team to build on their research into accessing money advice. This project will help us:

Accessibility Fund

Earlier this year, a group of members helped develop the criteria against which applications to this fund will be scored. Members will be invited be part of the process of awarding grants by joining a group which will score applications to the fund.

Access to Nature (part 2)

Having worked with a number of partner organisations which run sites around the county, the next phase of this project will be looking at helping to make local green spaces more accessible and inclusive.
