


Barnwood Circle Round Up

Projects Update

Research on Money Advice

Some Circle members have been working with our Research Team to test research methods on accessing advice on benefits, budgeting and debt. Involving circle members in research activities is new for us, and we're exploring ways for members to be more involved in future projects.

Social Media Workshops

Circle members joined in two sessions to share ideas about what makes engaging social media content. Your ideas are helping shape a brand-new social media strategy for later this year.

Disability Benefits Consultation

Earlier this year, the Government proposed changes that could make it harder for disabled people and people with mental health conditions to access benefits like Personal Independence Payment (PIP).

To help make sure as many disabled people as possible could share their thoughts with the Government, Barnwood Trust and Inclusion Gloucestershire worked with disabled people to create a simpler survey and supported local focus groups. Over 80 people shared their views.

The survey is now closed, and our teams are going through the responses.

We'll be sharing what we heard with Gloucestershire's 7 MPs and will submit the findings to the Government later this month.
