Welcoming community spaces can make a big difference to wellbeing. The Community Spaces Capital Grant has been set up to help create places where people can connect with others and do things together - inclusive spaces where everyone is made to feel welcome.

We support community space projects which enable people with disabilities and mental health problems to feel that they belong. For organisations with a focus on disability, we are interested in how the space can build new connections with the wider community.

Who and what is eligible

We consider community space projects which have a clear plan for building a more inclusive community. Groups or organisations that apply should have community or charitable purposes and be willing to 'go the extra mile' in terms of being welcoming and inclusive.
